

Charter Boat Information

2009 Wakayama Tasar World Championship

April 26, 2009 Japan Tasar Association

A few charter boats including brand new boats will be prepared for overseas sailors having difficulty bringing theirs own boats on the championships.

JTA would like to inform the conditions and how to apply for the charter boats. Please note that JTA cannot assure charter boats for all applicants due to limited number of candidate boats.

1. Charter fee

Brand new boat	¥150,000
Used boat	¥100,000
Deposit	¥100,000

- Charter fee and Deposit should be paid in advance.
- The deposit on damage would be refunded if there has been no damage to the boat.
- An insurance against damage on boat is included in the charter fee. However, it does not guarantee that all types of damage are covered. JTA will notify you details of the insurance package when you receive the charter boat

2. Application

Please send e-mail to info2009@tasarworlds.sakura.ne.jp with the following points.

- a. Skippers name
- b. Region/ District
- c. Type of charter boat (brand new boat or used boat)
- d. Sails which you will use the regatta (Mylar or Dacron)
- e. Crew weight (kg)
- f. Contact address (e-mail or facsimile numbers)



3. Condition of the charter boats

- a. JTA will provide a hull with a trolley or rigging boards, spars (mast and boom), whisker pole, dagger board, rudder and tiller.
- b. Sailors are responsible for bringing the other things, e.g. sails, battens, control lines, riggings and wind indicator.
- c. Mylar sails are available on the charter boats. If you use Dacron sails, you should bring jib furler and other equipments required.
- d. JTA will prepare ballast for minimum hull weight if necessary. JTA will also prepare ballast for minimum total crew weight if requested.
- e. Sailors must take responsibility to any damages on the charter boat during period of charter.
- f. An insurance against damage on boat is included in the charter fee. However, it does not guarantee that all types of damage are covered. JTA will notify you details of the insurance package when you receive the charter boat.

4. Assignment and return

- a. Boats will be assigned by drawing. Drawing will start at 15:00 at main office on 18th September.
- b. If applicants fail to come to the drawing, remaining boats will be assigned on a first-come-fist serve basis.
- c. After completing the regatta, boats shall be returned promptly.
- d. At the time of both assignment and return, the condition checking will be carried out in the presence of both organizer and applicants.
